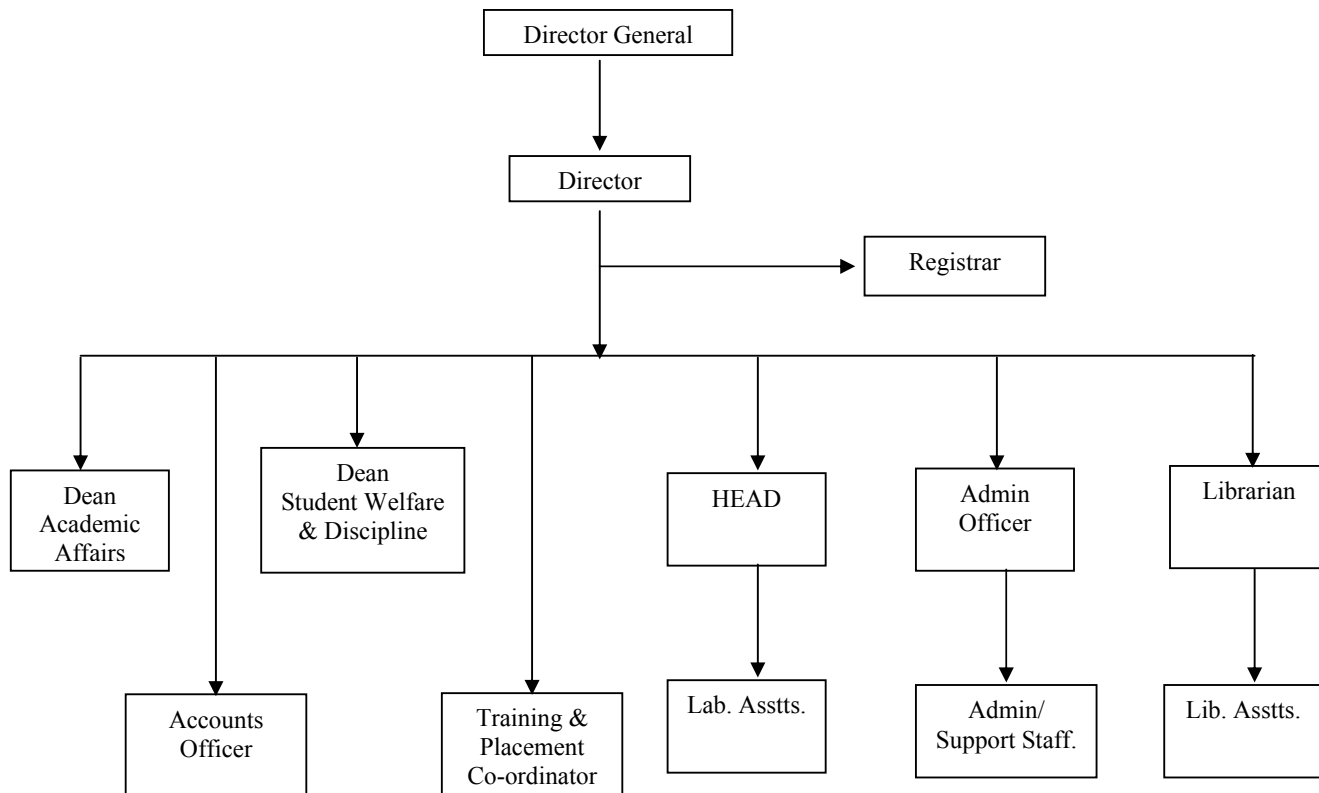

11. GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL MECHANISM FOR FACULTY, STAFF & STUDENTS:

There is a built in mechanism of grievances handling. Fortnightly staff meetings are held to address grievances of staff and students. At least once a month such meetings are presided over by the Vice-President/President of the foundation/society running the institute.

For the overall welfare and development of the students, a students counseling cell has been constituted in the institute under the supervision & guidance of Dean of Students Welfare (DOSW). As per the norms of the cell, each faculty of the Institute has been assigned with 15 students, whom She/He has to provide counseling and assistance in the academic and psychologics issues of the students. Following guidelines help faculty members to understand his duties, responsibilities and scope of guardianship as Students' Counselor.

- (1) Keeping and updating record of each student.
- (2) Watching and recording interest area of students.
- (3) Observing the weak areas and helping students to hide over the problem.
- (4) To develop health teacher – pupil relationship inculcating a sense of relationship, confidence, sharing and caring.
